India, US sign 10-year defence framework

AS THEY CONTINUE to negotiate a bilateral trade deal and the thorny issue of a tariff penaltyby Washington over Delhi's purchase of Russian oil, India and the US Friday signed a 10-year Framework for the US-India Major Defence Partnership, signalling stable ties between the two countries in the defence sector. in the defence sector.

The pact was signed following bilateral meeting between Defence Ministers Rainath Singh and his US counterpart Peter Heggesth on the side-lines of 12th Asean Defence Ministers' Meeting – Plus (ADMM-Plus) in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

In a statement, the ministry of defence said the 2025 framework is intended to provide a unified vision and policy direction to deepen defence cooperation. It said the framework will usher in a new era in the already strong defence partnership between the two countries and marks a new chapter in further transforming it over the next 10 years.

Singh said the framework will provide policy direction to the entire spectrum of the india-US defence relation with partnership. BHARAT PETROLEUM CORPORA-

BHARAT PETROLEUM CORPORATION (BPCL) on Firlday reported a 169% jump in its September quarter net profit on the back of a surge in refining margins.

Its standalone net profit of 64,442.55 crore in July-September—the second quarter of FY26—was 169% higher than ₹2,397.93 crore earned in the same period last year, according to a stock exchange filing by the company.

The company earned \$10.78 on turning every barrel of crude oil into fuels like petrol and diesel, compared to a gross refining margin of \$4.41 per barrel in July-September 2024.

Centre's gross tax receipts rise 2.8% in H1FY26

THE CENTRE'S GROSS tax revenue (before devolution to states) grew by a subdued 2.8% to ₹18.65 lakh crore in the first half of FY26, dragged down by lacklustre performance in both direct and indirect taxes.

This pace falls well short of the 12.5% annual growth required to meet the FY26 target of ₹42.7 lakh crore.

Corporate tax collections inched up just 19% to ₹4.7 lakh crore, far below the 10% growth needed to reach the full-year goal of ₹10.82 lakh crore.

Personal income tax receipts fared slightly better, rising 4.7% to ₹5.9

slightly better, rising 4.7% to ₹5.9 lakh crore—still only a fraction of the lakh crore—still only a fraction of the 21.6% annual growth required to achieve the ₹14.3 slakh crore target. The slowdown is partly attributed to major tax relief measures in the FY26 Budget, including raising the exemption il limit under the new regime to ₹12 lakh from ₹7 lakh and reducing rates across slabs. These steps have put an estimated ₹1 lakh crore back into taxpayers' pockets to spur consumption and investment.
