

Q1: VEDANTA ADDS HIGHEST RETAIL SHAREHOLDERS

VEDANTA ADDED THE highest number of retail shareholders during the June quarter, with its retail investor base rising from 2.05 million in March to 2.54 million, Capitaline data show. Wipro, Bajaj Auto, HDFC Bank and Reliance Industries also witnessed a significant increase in retail shareholder numbers. On the other hand, Tata Motors PV, Yes Bank, Suzlon Energy, Adani Green Energy and BHEL recorded a fall in their retail shareholder base. Despite the decline, Tata Motors PV continued to have the highest number of retail shareholders at 6.09 million, followed by Yes Bank (5.76 million) and Vodafone Idea (5.68 million).
